<u>Evidence Centre</u>	A concise synopsis of best evidence in a palliative care/aged care context. Each page has a companion page with practical information found in the Evidence in Practice Centre.
Symptoms and medicines	A single gateway to information on the eight most commonly encountered terminal phase symptoms, and information on prescribing and management of medications in palliative care.
palliAGEDnurse App	A free smartphone app to support clinical processes of advance care plan, case conference, and terminal care management plan. The companion palliaGEDgp App supports prescribing in the terminal phase. Both Apps are available in desktop version .
