### What is palliAGEDnurse

palliAGEDnurse is a free app that helps nurses care for older people who have a disease or illness that cannot be cured or who are becoming frail.

### Who should use the app

The app is designed for nurses working in residential aged care, providing care in the community and in general practice.

The app is simple to use and easy to navigate quickly. Navigation is built around the following care processes:

- Understanding the Palliative Approach Framework
- Advance Care Planning
- Palliative Care Case Conference
- Terminal Care Planning

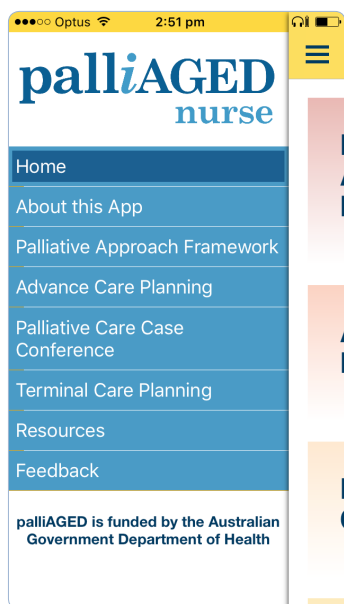
### What makes
